### 3. Procedure for voting on line:

#### A. Go to

B. Log in. You will need your **Member No. and E-signature (election passcode) to register**. You must have got these from ASCE headquarters by now, if you are an eligible voter.

C. Once registered, follow the online voting instructions.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

During our campaigning it has become apparent to us that some of the International members have not received their ballot paper/e-signature. Our enquiry revealed that this could be due to one of two reasons:

1. Change of address provided on the ASCE data base – the ballot paper has been sent to the address in ASCE's d-base;
2. Eligibility requirement – the member have not been current on their annual dues

The following communication is from ASCE headquarters

*"I'm finding that many of the international members are not eligible to vote-- mostly because they have not been current on their annual dues. Ballots to international ballots were distributed by special mail service, so they should have been received by now. There would be no way for me to check if each international member received their paper ballot since we don't send those out with any type of receipt requested. If you have specific names of individuals you want me to check regarding eligibility, and can provide a valid e-mail address, I will be happy to check on those members.*
